### Billericay Town Football Club

Billericay Town Football Club was formed in 1880 making it the 11th oldest club in Essex. It moved into the Romford & District League in 1890 competing in this league until 1914.

Billericay Town became the first [and so far the only] club to win the F.A.Vase for a third time in 1979 when they defeated Almondsbury Greenway 4-1. This match was notable for a hat-trick by Doug Young - the first hat-trick in a Cup Final at Wembley Stadium since Geoff Hurst's in the 1966 World Cup Final. The club now play in the Ryman League Premier Division

The trophy's have rolled in, with the first team winning the Essex senior trophy, the U'18s are quadruple winners of , League title, county cup, league cup and Grand EJA champions., the U'16's won their county cup and both ladies teams won promotion.
